SUMMER ACADEMIC PROGRAMME

ATC's Summer Academic Programme aims to engage and motivate young learners through active and interesting lessons, encouraging maximum communication between students and helping them grow in confidence while learning English. The curriculum is designed against the CEFR and all levels are offered, A1-C1.

The syllabus operates on a 4 weekly basis and has been developed with active learning and the students' experience in mind.

Our timetable is planned so that there are 2 lessons per day, over 5 days per week, with alternating morning and afternoon classes.

It also includes a Learning Diary for students to make notes, record new words and phrases, and reflect on what they learn and experience each day.


ATC Online:
